General Requirements for Admission

Nassau Community College has an open admission policy guaranteeing admission to students who meet the criteria outlined below. Applicants must meet one of the following:

1. Possess an official high school transcript with graduation date or high school equivalent diploma (TASC/GED).
2. Meet the Home-Schooled Student requirements.
3. Enroll in the New York State 24 College Credit TASC Program (formerly known as GED).

Prospective students are not required by the college to submit standardized test scores such as SAT or ACT. However, submission of these test scores may waive the student from some or all parts of the placement tests.

Placement exams in the areas of English, Reading and Mathematics may be required as part of the admission process. Students whose placement test scores indicate placement in developmental courses must enroll in these courses in their first semester of attendance at NCC.

Programs in health related areas and Mortuary Science may require a background check and/or drug screening prior to being eligible for acceptance. Information about specific requirements may be found by contacting the department.

All science courses must have been taken within the last 6 years. Chances of admission are increased for applicants who have completed some or many of the courses that are part of the program. Transfer applicants must be in good academic standing at previous college. All applicants: Interview required. Must be legally eligible for licensure and employment in the U.S. at time of application. Placement in remediation will remove applicant from consideration.

All applicants: The TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) is required of all applicants. Register at: www.ati.com for the exam for nursing students and have scores forwarded electronically to NCC’s Office of Admissions (admissions@hcc.edu). Minimum composite TEAS score of 58.7 required. Submit a 300-word essay, describing your reasons for wishing to enter this field and the qualities you possess that will enable you to become a capable radiation therapist. Required research: applicants must research what the roles and responsibilities of a licensed radiation therapist are, and have a basic understanding of the job description. Interview required. All accepted applicants must pass a criminal background check and drug testing, at the cost of the applicant. Must be legally eligible for employment and licensure in the U.S. at the time of application. Must be at least 18 years old on the first day of the first semester. Placement in remediation will remove applicant from consideration. Some accepted students may have to take courses prior to their first semester.</p>

High school requirements must be met prior to the start of senior year. Transfers: Applicants lacking one or more high school requirements and students transferring with college courses must complete ENG 101, a 3-or-4-credit, non-remedial math course, and either AHS 131 or a semester of college science (biology, chemistry or physics). Overall college cumulative GPA must be 2.85 or above. All applicants: The TEAS (Test of Essential Academic Skills) is required of all program applicants. Register at www.ati.com for the exam for nursing students, and have scores emailed to: admissions@ncc.edu. Minimum composite TEAS score of 58.7 required. Applicants are strongly encouraged to attend an Information Session; see NCC website for dates and times. Must submit an essay by program deadline, no longer than 250 words, describing your knowledge of the occupation and reason(s) for choosing the field, and emailed to admissions@ncc.edu. Chances for program admission are increased for applicants who have completed the Liberal Arts courses that are part of the Radiologic Technology curriculum. Interview required.
